I understand that the job of Student Poll Worker requires me to attend an in-person training class, complete online training, assist with setting up the Vote Center on the Monday prior to the election, and to work at the Vote Center on Election Day from 5:15 AM until all work at the Vote Center is completed (approximately 9:00 PM). I understand that I must be registered to vote in Yavapai County if I am 18 years old by Election Day.

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Student Poll Worker Requirements

- Must be a high school student, 16 years of age or older by Election Day.
- Must be registered to vote in Yavapai County if 18 years of age by Election Day.

How to Apply

- Application must be signed by the student, a parent or guardian and the school principal.
- Submit by email, mail, or drop-off (see below).
- Applicants will be contacted for placement; selection depends on available positions and program needs.

Before Election Day

- **Online Poll Worker Training:** Watch all online training videos prior to in-person training.
- **In-Person Training:** attend a 2-3 hour in-person session approximately two weeks before the election.
- **Pre-Election Set-Up Meeting:** Held the Monday before Election Day, scheduled between 11:00 AM-6:00 PM (approximately 2 hours).
- Notify your school in advance of all absences related to training, setup & Election Day.

Election Day

- Arrive by 5:15 AM and serve until approximately 9:00 PM.
- You may not leave the voting location from the time of your arrival to the time your work is finished for the day. Bring everything you will need for the day such as breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks, drinks, water, medicine, and a sweater!
