Yavapai County Jail District Excise Tax Extension

The Board of Directors of the Yavapai County Jail District asks the voters of Yavapai County for approval to extend the existing jail district excise (sales) tax of up to 1/4 of a cent per dollar (\$0.0025) for an additional twenty years to continue revenues necessary to support the county jail system. The estimated yearly revenue needs for the Jail District are currently a minimum of \$18.1 million per year, and will likely increase over time due to population growth and inflation. The County currently contributes \$7 million per year to the Jail District from the County General Fund as legally required "maintenance of effort," with most of the remaining funds raised through the existing jail district excise (sales) tax. The proposal extends the existing jail district excise (sales) tax at its current rate.

Shall the existing Yavapai County Jail District excise (sales) tax on eligible sales within Yavapai County of up to 1/4 of a cent per dollar (\$0.0025) continue until June 30, 2040?

A "YES" vote shall have the effect of approving extension of the existing jail district excise (sales) tax of up to 1/4 of a cent per dollar of eligible sales (\$0.0025) until June 30, 2040.

A "NO" vote shall have the effect of ending funding of county jail system through the jail district excise (sales) tax on June 30, 2020.
